

BREAK-OPEN TICKET POLICY

- 1. Permits will only be issued to:
 - a. On-reserve organizations fundraising for the benefit of the community.
 - b. Other on-reserve organizations subject to Band Council approval.
- 2. Permits for organizations other than the Nipissing First Nation (NFN) Bingo will only be issued for tickets with a selling price not exceeding \$1.00 and a prize value not exceeding \$250. Maximum ticket price for the NFN Bingo is \$1.00 with a prize value not exceeding \$1,000.

All break-open (Nevada) tickets must be purchased from Nipissing First Nation.

- 3. Permits will only be issued for a duration not to exceed 6 (six) months in length.
- 4. The applicant must submit a written request for a permit to the Nipissing First Nation Economic Development Department using the prescribed form.
- 5. The applicant must specify the location (address) where the tickets are to be sold and shall not sell tickets at any other location than that specified on the application. Permits will not be issued for sales from a private residence.
- 6. The applicant must maintain all funds raised in a Band Account.
- 7. The applicant may negotiate with their seller to a maximum of 20% of sales.
- 8. The applicant shall not permit ticket sales to any person under 18 years of age.
- 9. After one year, the location for ticket sales of an organization may be rotated with the location of another organization if approved by both Band Council and seller.
- 10. Should the applicant fail to comply with any of the above regulations and the Terms & Conditions (attached), the permit may be suspended, cancelled or denied renewal.
