

### **BEAUTIFICATION**

The Beautification program has been growing steadily since its launch in 2007. Beautification focuses on activities that enhance the usability and appearance of NFN recreational and public spaces. The Beautification program runs from May - December.

#### **Activities**

- Beach clean up
- Brushing
- Cemetery maintenance
- Parks and Playgrounds
- · Roadsides and Ditching
- Trail maintenance
- Event Support Annual Traditional Pow Wow, Community Events, National Indigenous Day and Special Events

# **SENIORS LAWN CARE**

The Seniors Lawn Care program runs from May - September, weather dependent. Each year NFN membership Seniors must meet the eligibility criteria, review the policy, and complete a Waiver of Liability.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Must be a registered NFN member 65 years of age or over;
- The senior is a primary owner/tenant and the home is on NFN land within the area being serviced by Public Works;
- Requests to be made to Facilities Manager.

# Seniors who meet the criteria, will be advised of the following:

- The homeowner or primary tenant must ensure that their property is clear of any large obstacles or debris;
- The Seniors Grass Cutting program is strictly intended for grass cutting services of seniors primary residence;
- Senior must sign a "Waiver of Liability" each year to accept services.
