Re: First Nations Reserve Cannabis Retail Store Application

On October 22, the Government amended Ontario Regulation 468/18 to allow for the authorization of up to 26 cannabis retail stores on First Nations reserves. This letter serves as notification from the Registrar that the following completed Retail Store Authorization Intent to Apply-First Nations Reserve applications for on-reserve stores in Nipissing First Nation community were of the first 26 received by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) before August 1, 2019. The AGCO has notified the following applicants to apply for a Retail Store Authorization:
