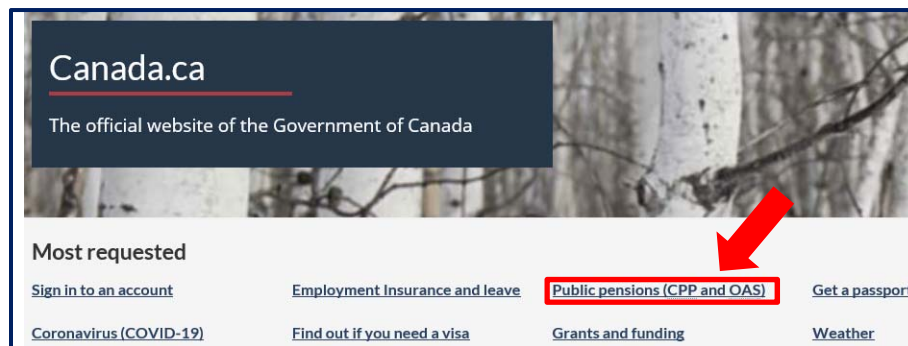


Are you trying to apply for the Canada Pension Plan (CPP)?

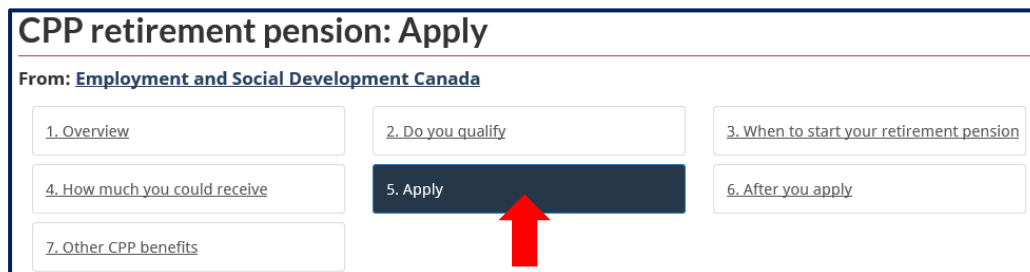
STEP 1: Type www.canada.ca into the search bar

STEP 2: Select “**Public pensions (CPP and OAS)**”



STEP 3: Select the benefit you would like to learn more about

STEP 4: After reviewing all relevant information found on this page, select “**5. Apply**”



STEP 5: Scroll down to either “**Online Application**” or “**Paper Application**”

STEP 6: Online applications must be completed through a *My Service Canada Account* (MSCA). If you do not already have an account, you must register for one. You will receive a *Personal Access Code* (PAC) to complete your registration. **Please note:** the PAC will be received via mail within 5 to 10 business days.

If you choose to fill out a **paper application**:

- print and complete the paper form application for the applicable CPP benefit
- include certified true copies of the required documents, and
- mail the application to the applicable processing centre found on the last page of the application form **or** submit at a Service Canada Centre drop box

STEP 7: Depending on the type of benefit you applied for, processing times will vary. You can view your application status in the MSCA by selecting the “Application Status” link.
