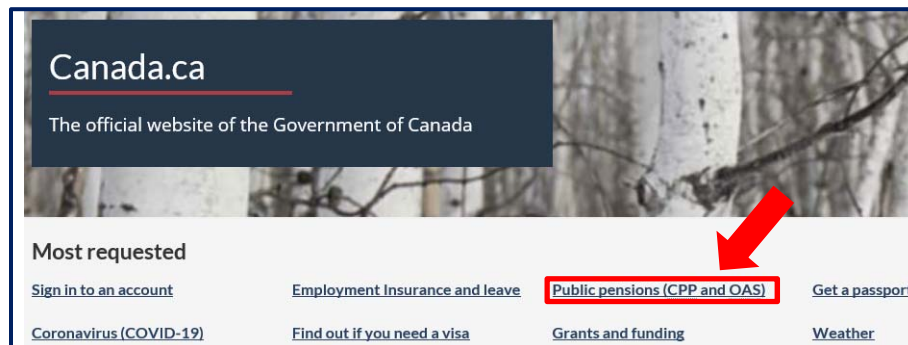


Are you trying to apply for the Old Age Security (OAS) Pension?

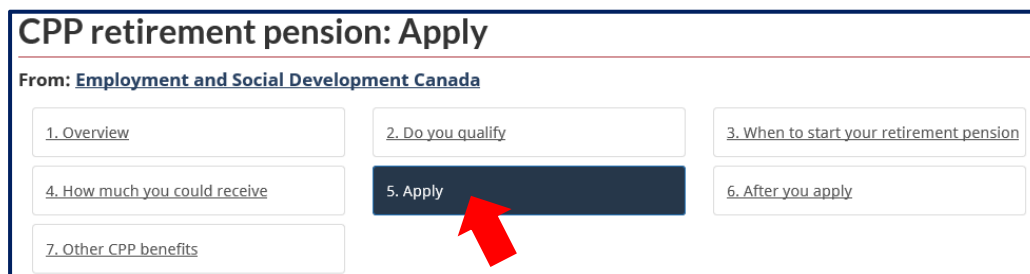
STEP 1: Type www.canada.ca into the search bar

STEP 2: Select **“Public pensions (CPP and OAS)”**



STEP 3: Under Services and Information, select **“Old Age Security Pension”**

STEP 4: After reviewing all relevant information found on this page, select **“5. Apply”**



STEP 5: Scroll down to either **“Online Application”** or **“Paper Application”**

STEP 6: Online applications must be completed through a *My Service Canada Account* (MSCA). If you do not already have an account, you must register for one. You will receive a *Personal Access Code* (PAC) to complete your registration. **Please note:** the PAC will be received via mail within 5 to 10 business days.

If you choose to fill out a **paper application:**

- print and complete the paper form *Application for the OAS and the GIS* (ISP-3550)
- include certified true copies of the required documents, and
- mail the application to the applicable processing centre found on the last page of the printed application form **or** submit at a Service Canada Centre drop box

STEP 7: You can view your application status in the MSCA by selecting the **“Application Status”** link.
