Aanin Nbisiing Redhawk families and students,

In response to Ontario's second declaration of emergency and to align Nbisiing with Nipissing First Nation's response to the provincewide stay-at-home order and shutdown restrictions, Nipissing First Nation (NFN) Council has approved changes to Nbisiing's return to in-person learning date.

In order to keep people home as much as possible to reduce the risk of spread of COVID-19 in our community, protect vulnerable populations, and keep our school community safe, Nbisiing will continue to teach all classes virtually and will return to in-person learning on **Tuesday, February 16th, 2021** (Monday the 15th is Family Day).

Final Exams:

As per the M.O.E. guidelines during Covid-19, Nbisiing will continue with the regular class schedule from Monday to Friday of next week. Students will log on at their usual class times and work on Culminating Activities in each class. Support has been scheduled for all students with IEPs.
