

CALL FOR TENDERS – DEADLINE EXTENDED

New Roadway Extension Clearing - Yellek Trail

July 29, 2021 – Tender applications from Nipissing First Nation members for the new roadway extension at the end of Yellek Trail has extended the deadline to **Friday, August 6, 2021**.

SCOPE OF WORK:

- Cut and remove all existing trees/brush/vegetation within Yellek Trail extension corridor.
- Corridor shall be no less than 66 feet (20 meters) wide.
- Corridor shall extend Yellek Trail Road 1.2 km (1,200 meters) beyond the existing roadway corridor.

Contractors submitting Tenders are required to complete all Tender documents including, but not limited to the following: Tender, Contractors Qualifications and Detailed Material Costs. The successful contractor must also provide a Clearance Certificate from W.S.I.B. prior to the commencement of the project.

MATERIALS AND LABOUR SHALL AT ALL TIMES COMPLY WITH THE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE. THE WORK COMPLETED IS TO BE GUARANTEED FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF COMPLETION.
