

# Notice of Start of Construction

## New Roadway Connecting Yellek & Duchesnay

**December 3, 2021** – Nipissing Miller will begin construction of the road to connect Yellek and Duchesnay on Monday, December 6, 2021. This new road will start from the railway crossing at the corner of Nova Beaucage Road in Yellek and end at the northwest corner of Goulais Crescent in Duchesnay, with completion slated for the fall of 2022.

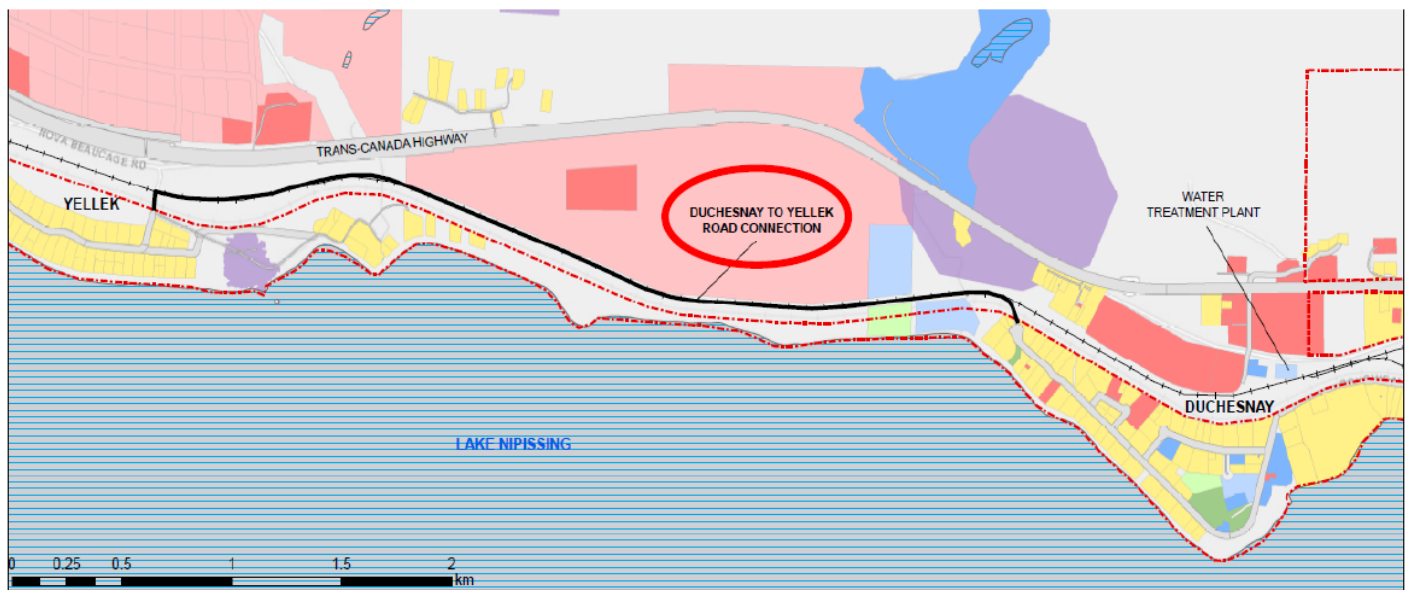
Over the next 3 weeks, the Nipissing Miller crew will be mobilizing equipment and completing clearing on and along the new roadway. **The railway bed will be closed to all traffic** (pedestrians, ATVs, snowmobiles) **for the duration of the project**. Signage will be posted to restrict all access and use of the rail bed to protect the safety of community members. Miigwech for your cooperation.

When the road is completed next year, it will provide a much needed and safe local road link for school buses and residents wishing to avoid travelling on highway 17. It will also open up land for development and provide a secondary means of emergency access to both communities to improve fire and emergency service response times.
