CULTURAL ARTS PROGRAMMING

Nipissing First Nation provides funding for Cultural Arts Programming through own source revenues under the Culture & Heritage Department as a means to re-introduce native artisan revival projects to its members. Nipissing First Nation Council approves the following procedures for accepting registrations to cultural arts programming.

Eligibility:

Due to the high interest in registrations, the following priority will be used for accepting registrations:

- (1) Nipissing First Nation registered members.
- (2) Children of Nipissing First Nation registered members who are not entitled to be registered and spouses.
- (3) Members from other First Nations. *(full registration cost applies)*

Registration and Supply Costs:

The Culture & Heritage Department makes every effort to keep costs to a minimum however in order to remain within budget, fees may apply for crafts that are high in cost.

Due to the high interest in sessions, fees paid with no cancellation notice are non-refundable.

Process:

- (1) Individuals will not be permitted to submit multiple registrations.
- (2) Individuals must call prior to the deadline date and if payment is required, payment must be received to complete the registration.
