The Parks & Recreation Supervisor will oversee the Parks & Recreation team as it relates to the Beautification Project. The Supervisor will lead maintenance, building and repair work on NFN public spaces and assist with Elders or community members requiring assistance with outdoor clean up and maintenance. The Parks & Recreation Supervisor will complete program reports, weekly/daily tasks and project deadlines as assigned by the Public Works Manager.

- Provide clear directional supervision of staff, cleaning and maintenance services for Nipissing First Nation properties and spaces

- Assist in scheduled equipment care, maintenance, and inventory
