Ontario and NFN Boundary Claim Negotiations Update

Nipissing First Nation claims that the boundaries of the reserve surveyed under the Robinson-Huron Treaty 1850 differ from what Nipissing Nation understood they were entitled to receive. Ontario accepted Nipissing Nation's claim for negotiation in April 2022. Negotiations between Nipissing Nation and Ontario, led by the Ministry of Indigenous Affairs, began in June 2022 and are currently underway.

Negotiations are confidential and very early in the process. As negotiations progress, Ontario will undertake consultation with Nipissing Nation, stakeholders, and members of the public.
