As an IT Technician, you will be responsible for diagnosing and repairing computer hardware and software issues, installing, and configuring software and hardware, and maintaining our company's network and server systems. You should possess a strong understanding of computer systems, network protocols, and network security.

- Provide technical support to Staff using IT support tickets and responding to calls, including troubleshooting hardware and software issues, resolving technical problems, and installing software and hardware components.
- Manage and administer Office 365 applications and services, ensuring smooth operation and optimal performance.
- Monitor and maintain computer systems, network communications, and network security systems.
- Implement and maintain regular backups for staff data, ensuring data integrity and availability in the event of data loss or system failures.
- Maintain and update system documentation and inventory for all hardware and software assets.
- Install, configure, and maintain servers, including email servers, database servers, and file servers
