What you'll do in the role

- Perform routine inspections pre-start inspections before the utilization of Zamboni.
- Perform routine maintenance grease, knife changes, report any major breakdowns.
- Perform routine and minor maintenance repairs to rink surfaces.
- Ensure that equipment is in good working order.
- Responsible for maintenance of multiple recreational facilities throughout NFN.
- Respond to community needs and public inquires/concerns as related to recreation activity programming.
- Conduct routine /assigned maintenance repairs when necessary and keep maintenance logbook up to date.
- Able to work with minimal supervision, demonstrate initiative and work effectively in a team environment.
- Ensure recreational areas are safe for member use
- Ensure that all hazards are addressed and reported on ice surface.
- Be cautious for slips, trips, and falls.
- Ensure Safe Operating procedures are followed when handling Propane Cylinders.
- Other tasks as assigned.

- Opportunities are open to spouses and children of registered Nipissing First Nation members and registered members of other First Nations. Please advise your status in your application
- Applicants who are considered Round 3 will not be considered, regardless of when the application is received.
- If no suitable candidate is found, the process will proceed to Stage Three

Closing December 1, 2023 - 3rd Round

- Opportunities are open to all applicants (status and non-status)
- The posting will be open until filled.
