Operators will work both independently and as part of a team to ensure that walkways and driveways are cleared and sanded, ensuring the safety of our community's Seniors.

What you'll do in the role

- Provide both regular and emergency snow clearing services for Seniors' driveways across Nipissing First Nation.
- Ensure all driveways are properly cleared and sanded to maintain safe access to residences.
- Work hours will vary based on weather conditions and service needs.
- Adhere to all safety protocols and requirements, including Public Health guidelines for infection prevention.
- Conduct and document necessary inspections to ensure property safety before and after service.
- Perform routine maintenance and inspections of equipment, including storage, cleaning, and repairs, to ensure it is in safe working order prior to use.
- Comfortable working outdoors during winter, with exposure to cold weather and challenging conditions.

- Applicants who are considered Round 3 will not be considered, regardless of when the application is received.
- If no suitable candidate is found, the process will proceed to Stage Three

Closing December 13, 2024 - 3rd Round

- Opportunities are open to all applicants (status and non-status)
- The posting will be open until filled.
