

Miskwaabik (Beaucage Park) Hours of Operation & Rules of Use

From May 18th to October 12th, Miskwaabik will be open for use.

As with other properties owned by NFN (Nipissing First Nation), Miskwaabik (Beaucage Park) is open to Debendaagziwaad (registered Nipissing First Nation members) and those accompanied by Debendaagziwaad.

We kindly request that all park visitors respect each other by keeping noise levels reasonable, allowing everyone to enjoy this beautiful area. As caretakers of the land, it is our responsibility to respect the environment and protect our natural resources. **Failure to comply with the Miskwaabik RULES OF USE will result in the loss of park privileges.** These rules include:

- Drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited at all times.
- Excessive noise will not be tolerated.
- Park users are responsible for supervising the children in their care.
- There are no lifeguards on duty, so use the park areas at your own risk.
- Proper safety equipment, such as lifejackets, must be used at all times.
- Cooking and campfires are only allowed in designated fire pit areas.
- All garbage must be placed in bags, removed from the site, and disposed of properly.
- The site and portable washroom facilities must be kept clean and tidy.
- Pets must be kept within site limits or leashed at all times.
- ATVs, minibikes, scooters, and golf carts are strictly prohibited.
- Please be cautious of any ongoing construction or maintenance work.
